What an exciting beginning of the Summer we've just had! Premiere and tour of "Fireflies at Dawn", outreach workshops and an inclusive dance festival. We've been busy at Unbound Dance Theatre, let's have a look at what we've been up to...



Highlights

Our June highlight was undoubtedly the premiere of "Fireflies at Dawn" at the Alhambra Studio in Bradford. After over two years of development, it was a beautiful experience to finally present this labour of love to our audience. The show, which sensitively reveals the living experiences of blind and visually impaired people, received an overwhelmingly positive response.

Following our Bradford premiere, we embarked on a pilot tour, bringing "Fireflies at Dawn" to Leeds on June 29th and Wakefield on July 10th. Each performance was a unique and emotional journey, and we were deeply moved by the warm reception we received at every venue.

We are incredibly grateful for our audience's support and enthusiasm. Sharing our work with you has been the most rewarding part of this journey.

One audience member shared, "The thought, energy and forward-thinking of the choreography was groundbreaking in a world of darkness. I was moved to tears at one point as something said sparked total recognition inside me and I don't cry easily! The dancers, both sighted and visually impaired were fabulous. Moving without constraints and with such freedom."

Another said: "A wonderful concept, beautifully delivered by a group of very genuine performers. They and the story conveyed so much about the emotions and issues felt not just by blind/VI people but by people who find themselves outside 'the norms' of the world."

Our team has worked tirelessly to present a show that is not only meaningful but also accessible and inclusive. Seeing our hard work come to life on stage and resonating with so many people is incredibly fulfilling. Looking ahead, we're excited to announce that more workshops will resume in September. Stay tuned for updates on our upcoming sessions and events.


